SAJAN AND DABHOSA - NEW DESTINATION FOR THE NATURE ENTHUSIASTS

Sajan is part of a beautiful terrain situated near Jawhar of Thane District in Maharashtra. Developed as a nature camping site, this 30 acre campus is a combination of nature and culture. The participants would spend the first 2 nights and 2 days in Sajan Nature Club campsite and enjoy activities like Rappelling, Valley crossing, Kayaking, Wall climbing, Swimming etc. Accommodation would be in dormitories or in bunk house with detached wash rooms and toilets

Dabhosa is situated on Silvassa Road, off Jawhar, in the same vicinity of Sajan. The participants would spend the 3rd night and 4th day at Dabhosa Waterfall Resort, where you would have a real feel of the wild and would enjoy activities like Trek to waterfall, river crossing, waterfall rappelling.

Accommodation would be in dormitories with multiple bedding.

MOUNT ABU

Set amidst lush green forested hills, MOUNT ABU is an oasis in the barren desertscape of Rajasthan. Situated at the height of roughly 4000 feet, this beautiful hill station is rich in forests, flora and fauna. Part of Aravali hills, the oldest mountain range in the world, Mount Abu is known for its gigantic blocks of rocks in different shapes, flowering shrubs and lovely lakes. The major fauna includes Sloth Bear, Leopard, Sambar, Red Spurfowl, and the rare green Munia.

Accommodation: In Tents. Six participants will share one alpine tent, separate for girls and boys. Washrooms & bathrooms would be of make-shift kind. during the camp. The organisers will not be responsible for loss, theft or any damage. Doctor's certificate would be required if the participant is undergoing any medical treatment or is over-weight or above 60 years.

WHITE WATER RAFTING - JAYALGARH

Jayalgarh is approximately 90 kms from Rishikesh near Devprayag, away from any tourist destinations or place of pilgrimage. Pitched up on the bank of the gushing River Alaknanda, this campsite would be a wonderful retreat for the entire family, a group of friends or just for you.

Activities: White Water Rafting, Kayaking, Slithering, Rappelling, Hiking, Bonfire and games like Cricket, Volleyball, Swimming, etc.

Accommodation The camp provides comfortable accommodation in luxurious tents. Independent wash rooms, toilets for each tent and a well laid out dining area facing the river enhance the quality of this campsite.

Please Carry: Four pair of clothes, shorts or comfortable fit track pants (for rafting), sweater / jacket, bath towel, sunscreen lotion, cap, sunglasses, string for spectacles, torch (with extra batteries), socks, sports shoes, floaters / sandals, water bag with strap and sanitary requisites, etc....
