NAINITAL

- CORBETT NATIONAL PARK
- RANIKHET

Built around the shores of a mountain lake and surrounded by forested slopes, NAINITAL is one of the most popular hill stations in Northern India. A combination of lakes and mountains make this hill station worth visiting.

Nestling in the foothills of the Himalayas, CORBETT NATIONAL PARK invites you to enjoy the close proximity of the wildlife. It offers a variety of wild species – 50 mammals including the tiger, 580 birds and 25 reptiles.

Spread along a ridge at 6000 feet above sea level, RANIKHET is covered with pine and oak forests. Views of beautiful snow clad mountains on its northern side make Ranikhet a must see in the itinerary.
